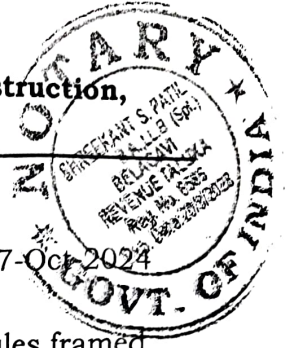

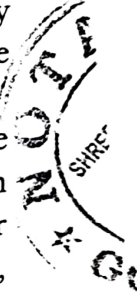

Conditions:

1. The school has been registered under the Right of Children Education Act 2009, and the Karnataka Education Act 1983 and the rules made thereunder, and the recognition has been renewed up to the registered class. No additional classes and additional sections are permitted to be conducted outside these classes.
2. The school shall function under the Karnataka Education Act 1983 and the Right of Children Education Act 2009, rules made thereunder.

3. Right of Children Education Act 2009, under the rules made thereunder, 25% seats will be reserved for children from weaker sections. The government will have the power to enrol the seats reserved by the government for schools falling under the purview of RTE. [The government has made rules to facilitate enrolment in schools near the residence of the parents of the children, and accordingly, if there are government or government-aided educational institutions, the children will be enrolled in that school] In case there are none, private schools will be allowed to enrol the children enrolled by the government and continue their education up to the primary level. These children will be allowed to continue their studies without any discrimination.
4. As explained in Section 3, the Government shall waive the fees of the children enrolled under the RTE Act as per the rules. Therefore, it is prohibited to collect any fees from these children.
5. The school and the school management prohibited the collection of any competition fees and voluntary donations from parents either at the time of registration or later.
6. The school/management board shall publish the information on the fees collected from the parents of the children in their school as tuition fees on the departmental website and on the school notice board as per the State Government Notification No.: ED:31:PGC:2019, Date:27.07.2019. No fee shall be collected in excess of the prescribed fee.
7. The school/management board shall enrol students within the period specified by the government.
8. The school/management cannot refuse admission against the following factors.
 - (i) Due to lack of proof of age.
 - (ii) On the basis of caste, religion, place of birth, language.
 - (iii) If admission is requested after the extended period of admission.
9. All safety measures to be taken as per RTE Act and Rules, Karnataka Education Act and Rules. [Fire Safety and Building Safety Certificate from concerned authorities and safety of children's learning as per K.S.C.P.C.R and N.C.P.C.R].
10. The school/management board is as follows:
 - (i) No child admitted shall be held in any class or expelled from the school until he/she completes his/her primary and secondary education in the school.
 - (ii) No child shall be subjected to physical or mental abuse.
 - (iii) No child is required to pass any board examination until the completion of primary education.
 - (iv) Every child who completes primary education will be issued a certificate as prescribed under Rule 21 of the RTE and the Karnataka Education Act and Rules.



(v) The school should also include children with special needs/special needs as per the provisions of the RTE Act and Rules and the Karnataka Education Act and Rules.

(vi) The appointed teachers shall possess the minimum educational qualifications as prescribed for primary and secondary school teachers in the RTE Act and Rules and the Karnataka Education Act and Rules and Government Orders.

(vii) The salary and allowances payable to the teachers and the terms and conditions of service shall be as prescribed by the State Government. The salary shall be paid to the teachers through Government Notification [Provident Fund (PF)] and other salaries payable by the bank and shall be covered by the Employee State Insurance (ESI).

(viii) Teachers shall perform the duties prescribed under Section 24[1] of the Act and the RTE Act and Rules and Rule 17 of the Karnataka Education Act and Rules and shall not engage themselves in private tuitions for supervisory considerations.

1. School shall follow the academic state curriculum and state text books to which the school is affiliated.
12. The school shall maintain the rules and norms as specified in Section 19 of the Karnataka Education Act. To appoint departmental staff as prescribed in the Karnataka Education Act and Rules.
13. School buildings and other infrastructure facilities related to the school should not be given over to any commercial activities or political and non-academic activities, day or night.
14. The school should not be run for the profit of any individual or group or association.
15. The school should be audited by a Chartered Accountant and a copy should be submitted to the Deputy Director/Block Education Officer by the end of June every year.
16. The school will follow the language policy as per the government notification [Kannada Language Policy 2016].
17. The governing body and teachers will act in accordance with the RTE Act and the Karnataka Education Act and rules.
18. The school/board of directors shall strictly follow the rules and directives of the government and the department.
19. It has been made mandatory to upload school information in SATS by the end of March of each year as per the rules.
20. In case of violation of the above conditions, the school's accreditation will be cancelled as per the rules framed under the RTE Act 2009 and the Karnataka Education Act 1983.

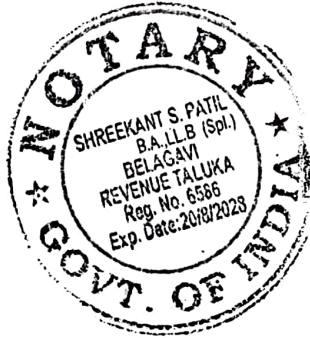


21. After the school accreditation process is completed, the entire document/information in the application submitted online by the governing body will be made publicly available on the departmental website.
22. In case of violation of the above conditions, the school's accreditation will be cancelled as per the rules framed under the RTE Act 2009 and the Karnataka Education Act 1983.
23. It is mandatory to update and upload the safety certificates and lease documents obtained from the competent authority in SATS within one month of their expiry.
